Fun Facts about Albuquerque

- Albuquerque was founded in 1706
- Albuquerque's altitude is 5,326 feet
- Albuquerque was the sheep herding center of the West. (There is a photo in the Library of sheep in the Front Lobby)
- Albuquerque is the Hot Air Balloon Capital of the world
- The Sandia Peak Tramway is 2.7 miles long, the longest in North America
- The tallest building is 22 stories (351 ft) tall.

Facts about Hotel Andaluz

- First Hilton in New Mexico
- It was the tallest building in the State
- Conrad Hilton was born in Socorro, NM

- July 6th, 1945 the Trinity Test was seen from the Hotel (As if 100 bulbs went off at once)
 - Placed on the National Register of Historic
 Places in 1984

The Casbahs names were inspired by the previous Hotel owners (Mr. Goodman) daughters
